



## PREVENT MEASURES TO ADOPT AGAINST COVID-19

The present report contains the preventive measures set out for the events organised during the new normality.

Upon the end of the state of alarm, and the consequent devolution of competencies to the autonomous communities, each one of these has developed a protocol of action for different activities, including ours.

At present, the state of new normality has no end date and it will remain in force until it is otherwise determined by the relevant authorities. Until then, we must abide by a number of prevention actions to be able to perform our usual activities.

### *General preventive measures. Measures concerning capacity*

#### **1. Capacity**

- Congresses, encounters, business meetings, conferences, trade fairs and other events, promoted by either public or private entities, can be organised and held, **but under no circumstances shall they exceed 75% of the capacity**, and they shall at all times respect the established interpersonal safety distancing
- The organisation of the movement of people and space distribution shall be modified, when necessary, with a view to ensuring the possibility of keeping the minimum safety distancing. If the venue has two or more doors, a differentiated use for entrance and exit can be established.
- Parking with contactless and etickets reader.

#### **2. General prevention obligations.**

- All citizens must adopt the necessary measures to prevent giving rise to risks of the spread of COVID-19 disease, as well as to avoid risk exposure. The owners and organisers of any activity must also abide by this precaution and protection obligation. Similarly, the measures of security and hygiene established by the health authorities for the prevention of COVID-19 must be respected.
- Interpersonal safety distancing. The measure of keeping interpersonal safety distance must be complied with as established in the Royal Decree Law 21/2020 of 9 June, on

urgent reform measures of prevention, containment and coordination to confront the health crisis caused by COVID-19, namely, at least 1,5 metres or, failing that, physical protection alternative measures by wearing suitable hygienic protective masks and respiratory etiquette. The obligation of wearing the protective mask shall apply except for those situations provided for in article 6.2 of the Royal Decree Law 21/2020 of 9 June.

### *General preventive measures regarding hygiene*

- Social distancing of at least 1.5 meters.
- Obligation to wear hygienic masks throughout the entire venue.
- Regular cleaning of used spaces with virucides. Disinfectants shall be used such as newly prepared bleach dilutions (1:50) or any other disinfectant with virucidal activity that can be bought from the market and are duly approved and registered.
- Daily ventilation of spaces by either manual or mechanical means.
- Toilet and bathroom occupancy decrease of 50%.
- Payment that does not imply physical contact between devices shall be encouraged, as well as cleaning and disinfection of the equipment needed for that purpose.
- There shall be bins to dispose of tissues and any other disposable material. Said bins shall be cleaned frequently and, at least, once per day.
- Provision of hydrogel dispensers in the areas where increased contact with objects and furniture is expected, such as bathroom areas or access to compartmentalised areas.
- Posters and other information documents shall be put up about hygiene and health measures for the proper use of services and facilities.

- A study has been carried out about the capacity of the venue to adapt it to the new normality. There is real-time capacity and temperature control.
  
- Lifts must be used by only one person or persons belonging to the same family unit.
